

MARCH 2022 – EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Alan called the meeting to order at 7:05, and explained his reasons for calling the special meeting: (1) to assess the impact of the Cincinnati Reds rescheduled Opening Day activities on the April 12, 2022 DRC annual meeting, and (2) to determine if the meeting should be rescheduled for April 11, 2022.

Alan laid out several considerations to weigh in making a decision:

- 1 - Numerous members have mentioned that they (and many others) will be attending the Reds game instead of the DRC meeting.
- 2 - The DRC Social that would have happened that evening after the meeting has been postponed to a later date in April because the planned site could not accommodate the DRC and the anticipated crowd of Reds fans.
- 3 - Captain Douglas Wiesman and/or Officer Timothy Eppstein of the CPD will not be available to attend the DRC meeting on April 12th because of Reds duty.
- 4 - Jim Curtis at the First Financial Innovation Center (our usual meeting location) has the room available for the DRC's proposed re-scheduled meeting time of Monday, April 11, 2022.

Jackie stated that, in her opinion, trying to hold the annual meeting on April 12 would be a disaster. Lisa agreed, and made a motion to move the meeting to April 11. Esther seconded and all voted in favor.

Alan agreed to send an e-blast to DRC members at the conclusion of the meeting and a reminder closer to the April 11 date. Jackie said she would get in touch with scheduled speakers to inform them of the date change. Alan will let Doug Weisman know and Jackie will tell Sara and Marissa from 3CDC.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:35.
