DRC Reports

Treasurer's Report-

Old Business:

A motion was made to approve the previous meeting's minutes, seconded, and all voted in favor.

New Business:

Tim Nolan reported the red-lined DRC Constitution submitted last month for member review was withdrawn by the Board to make membership definition updates. The changes will be presented at the November meeting and voted on in January 2024.

Speakers:

Alan Bunker introduced **Subhas Patel** of Keystone Hotels. Mr. Patel shared the redevelopment plan for converting the former "Chong" building at 616 Race Street into a Hilton Homes to Suites hotel. They plan to add two stories to the existing structure creating a six-story hotel. There will be 109 rooms with a first-floor restaurant. Subsequently, he addressed several questions from members.

Alan Bunker introduced Richard Eiswerth from Cincinnati Public Radio. Mr. Eiswerth shared a video of the groundbreaking event at the future home for Cincinnati Public Radio in Evanston. Its current location in downtown Cincinnati is being redeveloped and thus causing them to move. He encouraged members to pick up his business card and scan the QR code to see a virtual tour of the new building. Additionally, he addressed several questions from members.

The guide was prepared by the League of Women Voters of the Cincinnati Area to provide a forum for candidates and information on the November ballot issues.
